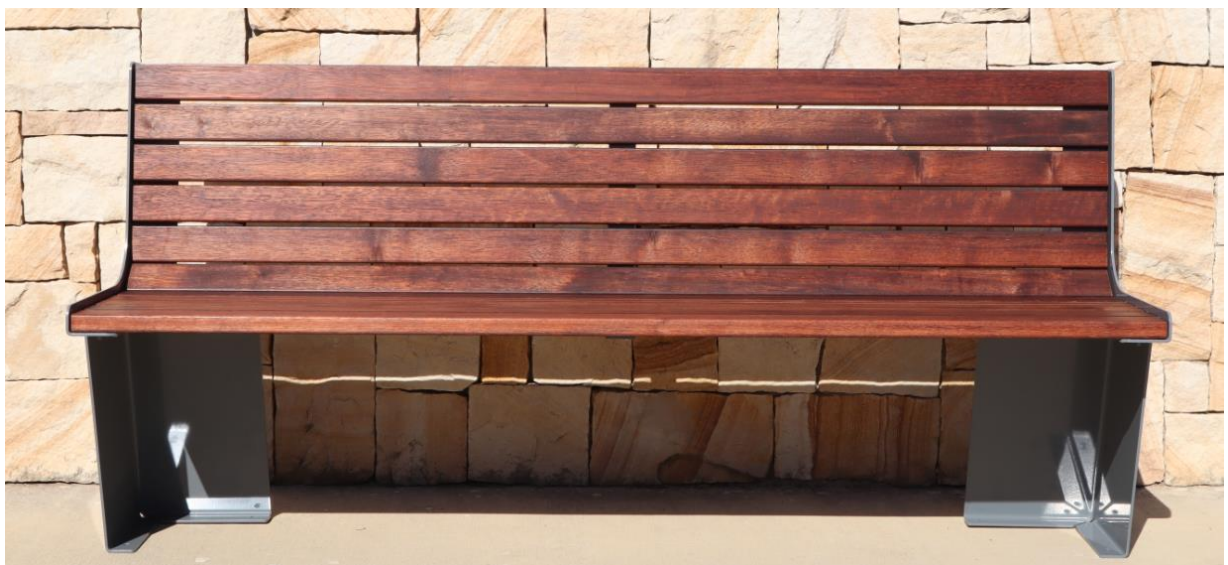


Certified Merbau Hardwood

Slat Sizes:

- 40x20mm (x length)
- 70x30mm (x length)

Weight per length:

- 40x20 x1800mm = 1.25 kg
- 70x30 x1500mm = 2.54 kg
- 70x30 x1800mm = 3.05 kg

Characteristics:

Common Name/s:	Merbau, Kwila, Ipil, Vesi
Scientific Name:	Intsia spp. (I. bijuga, I. palembanica)
Species Type:	Hardwood
Origin:	Native to the Indo-Pacific region but grows as far east as East Africa, to South East Asia, to Northern Queensland.
Sustainability:	*AVAILABLE ON REQUEST: Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Certified Timber – CoC (Lead time and costs apply) *STANDARD STOCK: Certified legally forested timber.
Colour:	Orangish-brown when freshly cut, which will age to a dark reddish-brown. There are also small yellow mineral deposits that are water-soluble and prone to bleeding (leaching). Natural colour variations and unique characteristics occur in timber which are not defects. They are what gives timber its character.
Grain/Texture:	Merbau has a dense, straight grain that is interlocked with a coarse texture.
Rot Resistance:	Rot and termite resistant.
Density:	670-800kg/m ³ @ 12 percent moisture content.
Stress Grade:	F11, F14, F17, F22 unseasoned, F14, F17, F22, F27 seasoned.
Durability:	Class 1 Hardwood above-ground (life expectancy more than 40 years), Class 3 hardwood when in-ground (life expectancy of up to 15 years).
Fire Properties:	Merbau is defined by AS-3959-2009 as bushfire-resisting timber: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spread of Flame Index (0-10): 0 • Smoke Developed Index (0-10): 5
Leaching:	Being a natural timber, Merbau will leach natural tannins from the timber, especially when new. See more details about leaching on our document ' Furniture Care – Timber Leaching. '

General Handling Instructions:

- When lifting furniture at any time, do not lift by the slats or they may pull off the frame. Hold the frame when lifting, not the slats.
- Inspect daily & clean all furniture surfaces regularly (at least weekly) using slightly soapy warm water and soft cleaning cloth.
- NOTE: Food scraps, soft drinks, juice spills etc, if left on surface can be harmful to surfaces of any kind.
- *Clean it, keep it looking good!*
